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



- The global waste management market size was USD 1,124.16 billion in 2023, accounted for USD 1,200.60 billion in 2024, and is expected to reach around USD 2,170.40 billion by 2033, expanding at a CAGR of 6.8% from 2024 to 2033
- Global Municipal solid waste generation is predicted to grow from 2.1 billion tonnes in 2023 to 3.8 billion tonnes by 2050




- The India Waste Management Market size was valued at USD 25.1 billion in 2023, and is expected to reach USD 39.07 billion by 2030, with a CAGR of 6.5% from 2023 to 2030.
- India currently generates 62 million tons of waste (both recyclable and non-recyclable) every year, with an average annual growth rate of 4%. Solid waste, plastic waste and E-waste are the principal waste materials.
- Waste generation in urban areas of India will be 0.7 kg per person per day in 2025
- Only about 23% of the total generated waste is being processed/treated (33,215 tons/day) while 72% is land-filled (1.22 lakh tons/day)







SERVICE-WISE REVENUE MIX ANALYSIS







Revenue Share (%)






GEOGRAPHY-WISE REVENUE MIX ANALYSIS




EBITDA & EBITDA Margin






